The university offers accommodation to incoming exchange students in Dorm A, a new and fully renovated dormitory, which can accommodate 50 students in 20 rooms.

Allocations are on a first come, first served basis. The student dorm has a 24/7 reception desk. The dormitory is comfortable and suitable for accommodation and study purposes, with all necessary facilities including LED TV, common kitchen on every floor (equipped with fridge, electric stove, microwave, electric mugs), self-service laundry room, study rooms and Wi-Fi internet access. For security reasons, there is CCTV (video surveillance) on every level/floor.

On campus, next to the cafeteria, there are also industrial washing machines, the access is free of charge and based on an online appointment (check https://campus.ugal.ro/spalatorie/).

- Rooms 301 and 320 (12 sgm each): 2 bathrooms, 4 students, no kitchen.
- Modules 303 A-B and 318 A-B: Each module has one 12 sqm room for 2 students and a 20 sqm room for 3 students, common bathroom, no kitchen.
- Modules 304-305, 306-307, 314-315 and 316-317: Each module has two 20 sqm rooms, each for 3 students, common bathroom, small kitchen.
- Modules 308-309, 310-311 and 312-312: Each module has two 15 sqm rooms, each for 2 students, common bathroom, small kitchen.
